As City Attorney, Lynden led an office of 11 civil attorneys and 13 criminal attorneys along with 11 support staff. After a change in administration, Lynden stayed on with the City as a litigation attorney defending varying claims, as well as handling land use appeal matters. Lynden gained experience in all areas of municipal defense and has tried over 30 cases in Municipal, Superior and Federal Courts.

When Lynden is outside the courtroom you will find him coaching youth soccer in Spokane, Washington. He has coached for over twenty years earning United State Soccer Federation licenses D, C and B.
